At one time better known as a professional skateboarder, Tommy Guerrero launched his musical career in 1998 with the release of Loose Grooves & Bastard Blues on Galaxia Records. He has since released a solid string of albums and EP's on Galaxia, Mo 'Wax, and Quannum Projects, including 2008's Return of the Bastard. A multi-instrumentalist, Tommy mixes up rhythm guitar, jazzy organs, hip-hop beats, samples, and latin influences to make music that is diverse, yet consistently funky, providing a great soundtrack to a variety of potential projects.

Over the last few years Tommy Guerrero's music has been heard in a number of places from video games to television commercials in Japan, the menus on Turner Classic Movie Network to CSI Miami and Sex and The City.
